Procedure:

Prospective student scholarship applications are reviewed and awards are granted based on the following criteria:

1. Education and career goal(s) that include previous music industry-focused activity and a clear, evidenced ambition to work within the music industry.
2. Portfolio of music you have produced, recorded DJ sets, live performances, events you have staged, artists/bands you have managed, relevant jobs you have held.
3. Minimum 70% "C" GPA from the last school graduated from; and
4. Family earnings are under \$60,000 per year, and a need is determined.

Each prospective student is notified in writing if an award has been granted via an award letter by the Registry team within 3 months after their application was received.

Scholarship terms and conditions;

1. The student must complete his/her chosen program within the allotted time frame for the course/program of enrollment.
2. The scholarship cannot be transferred to any other Point Blank courses or program.
3. The scholarship must be applied to a program offered at Point Blank.
4. The student will be expected to maintain satisfactory academic and attendance progress as outlined in the catalog. Failure to meet these academic requirements will result in the withdrawal of the scholarship.
5. If a student withdraws from the program for which a scholarship was awarded, the student forfeits the scholarship and is responsible for any balance due to Point Blank. Each scholarship is applied to costs outlined on the enrollment agreement and does not have a cash value that is refundable to the student.
